OVERVIEW

Medihoney Gel Sheet is a non-adherent dressing with 100% Pure Medical Grade Manuka Honey combined with Sodium Alginate.

FEATURES AND BENEFITS

- A totally natural product which contains 100% pure medical grade Manuka honey
- Delivers broad spectrum antimicrobial activity.
- Provides autolytic and enzymatic debridement through the osmotic action, effectively removing necrotic tissue and wound slough and breaking down fibrin in the wound bed
- Adjusts wound pH to the range 3-4 creating the optimum environment for wound healing
- Eliminates malodour, thus improving patients' quality of life
- Is safe to be used on all ages including paediatrics and neonates
- Can be easily cut, shaped or moulded to fit any wound type including cavities
- The dressing is activated by wound fluid or exudate and the honey is released slowly into the wound, creating the optimum pH levels and stimulating wounds to heal faster
- Is non sticky and slowly adjusts the wound pH minimising discomfort to patients
- Dissolves and is absorbed into the wound

- Leg ulcers (venous, arterial and mixed aetiology ulcers) and diabetic foot ulcers
- Pressure ulcers
- Infected and malodorous wounds
- Sloughy wounds
- Donor sites and recipient graft sites
- 1st and 2nd degree burns

HIDRADENTIS SUPPURATIVA, TISSUE INFECTION

A 17 year old male with a 3 year history of Hidradentis Suppuratia to bilateral axillae.
 A number of therapies had failed to heal the wound. Medihoney Gel Sheet was used which provided pain relief, exudate management and eliminated malodour. Healing was achieved within 7 weeks
